

White River provides a wide range of Millwork Design Services (preliminary sketches & elevations, 3D drawings and

build-ups in CAD) for residential and commercial projects. Our projects range from 25,000 sq. ft. interior projects to important rooms and remodels. Our staff of Master Millwork Designers have more than 100 years of combined experience in the specification of traditional millwork. We will work with your Architect or Interior Designer from initial concepts, build-ups, to full estimating. INITIAL SITE ASSESSMENT AND DESIGN

During the first jobsite visit, our Designer will review your room interiors for desired levels of millwork and create some initial sketch concepts and ideas to begin the design process. You should plan on 1/2 to 1 1/2 days for this initial meeting, depending on the scope of the job and services needed. Photos will be taken of each room and specific architectural features, to develop millwork design promptly, offsite.

PRELIMINARY DESIGN IDEAS AND CONFIRMATION

We will produce a visual picture of our millwork and moulding ideas. This may include, but is not limited to: elevations, sketches and 3D drawings, if necessary. With clear communications, revisions will be made. Once you are delighted with the interior drawn concepts, we will begin to create the technical CAD drawings. White River may need to work on 2-3 rooms at a time, or the entire project. This will be determined during the Initial Jobsite Visit. The design process can usually

progress as fast as the client allows. We estimate design time per room or job, in order to provide the information needed for the design fee deposit, which is prepaid at all times.

MEASURE AND REFINE

We will need accurate measurements to clarify the details for each room. After measurements are completed, build-ups in CAD will be created for your contractor or trim crews. During the Initial Jobsite Visit, our Designer will try to take as many measurements as is reasonable, but may need additional or finished dimensions at a later date. A jobsite millwork contact is a must.

MOULDING AND MILLWORK PROPOSAL

Depending on the scope of the project, the Client can have their contractor do the take-off and estimate cost. Upon request, White River can provide a material take-off and estimate, for a fee. In most cases, due to White River's expertise and product familiarity, we are asked to provide the estimate on more involved areas of the project.

EXPECTED COSTS AND FEES


- Hourly rate for all Design Services & Travel Time. Rate is based on project scope.
- Average investment for Initial Site Consultation is \$1,800-\$3,000, which includes airfare, some travel time, lodging, meals and jobsite time.
- Design Services are pre-paid and based on requested services.
- On certain projects, mouldings can be specified from the blueprints and photography.











Cornice comprised of 8 profiles





Door opening is 3'10" w x 8'10"h.


















BELOW: Coffered ceiling rendered in 2D CAD. This type of rendering helps in the dimensioning of the desired ceiling details into the allowable space.







ABOVE: Rendering depicts how a sagging existing ceiling can be leveled up with our coffered ceiling system.

RIGHT: Once all the coffers are fabricated, they are crated and shipped to you for installation.


After each coffer is in place, the beam bottoms and perimeter crown are installed on-site.
